



Driving Directions to Cobb Veterinary Clinic from:

Big Spring:

Exit off IH - 20 at Lamesa Exit (Hwy 137). Turn left under IH-20 and go through Stanton. At first stop sign go across the railroad tracks and head south on Hwy 137 for 5 miles. Turn right (west) at FM 307 (Greenwood), go 10 miles to SCR 1110. You will see Cobb Vet. Clinic sign at that intersection. Turn left. The clinic is 1 ¼ miles on the right.

Lamesa:

Option 1:

Leave Lamesa on Hwy 349. Take the turn toward the left to Stanton (Hwy 137). Continue south on Hwy 137 going through Stanton. At first stop sign go across the railroad tracks and head south on Hwy 137 for 5 miles. Turn right (west) at FM 307 (Greenwood), go 10 miles to SCR 1110. You will see Cobb Veterinary Clinic sign at that intersection. Turn left. The clinic is 1 ¼ miles on the right.

Option 2:

Leave Lamesa on Hwy 349. Before you get to Patricia turn Left (South) on 829. This road will dead end into FM 307. Take a right onto 307 and stay on it 3 miles past the school to SCR 1110. You will see Cobb Veterinary Clinic sign at that intersection. Turn Left. The clinic is 1 ¼ miles on the right.

Garden City:

Leave Garden City on Hwy 158. Turn right (north) onto FM1379. Go 8 miles to ECR 120 and turn left. Continue about 3 miles to SCR 1110 and turn right. You will see the Cobb Veterinary Clinic sign at that intersection. The clinic is 1 mile on the left.

Odessa:

Take I-20 East toward Midland to the Greenwood Exit (exit 140). Stay on the I-20 Service road at the stop sign turn Right. This will be Cloverdale road (FM 307). Go approximately 4.5 miles to SCR 1110 and turn right. You will see Cobb Veterinary Clinic sign at that intersection. Turn right. The clinic is 1 ¼ miles on the right.

Fairgrounds Rd./Front Street (Hwy 80) intersection:

Head South on Fairgrounds. Cross the RR tracks, go to the 4-way stop. Turn left onto Cloverdale (FM 307). Go approximately 6 miles to SCR 1110, take a right at this intersection, you will see Cobb Veterinary Clinic sign. The clinic is 1 ¼ miles on the right.
